Kennebunkport and Foster's Clambake Tour: Friday, September 11, 2009

Bus boarding will be at 10:00 am. We'll be visiting with Lenny (the 1700 pound chocolate moose). You can also shop for candy and famous Maine products like maple syrup. After visiting Lenny we'll go to Kennebunkport where you'll have time to eat lunch and to shop on your own. After that we have a two hour guided tour of the area which all leads up to the clambake. During the tour you'll see President Bush Senior's summer home, the Wedding Cake House, the Franciscan Monastery, and the tiny fishing villages of Wells and Ogunquit. We'll also be making a stop at the Lighthouse Gift Shop. The clambake menu will be: baked potatoes, Clam Chowder, Steamed Clams, Steamed Mussels, Corn on the cob, Blueberry Cake, and of course, Lobster. For anyone who can't eat Lobster or shellfish, there'll be Chicken available. For vegetarians there's even Eggplant Parmesan. The clambake also has entertainment and shopping. After the clambake we'll return to the hotel, and enjoy an evening in the hospitality room. \$58.00 per person.

Tour of Portland: Saturday September 12, 2009

Bus boarding will be at 9:00 am. We'll drive through the Old Port, the Waterfront District. You'll also pass the Victoria Mansion, the Portland Museum of Art, The Portland Observatory, the Eastern and Western Promenades, the Longfellow House and Longfellow's Statue. We'll go to Portland Headlight at Fort Williams Park. (Portland Headlight was commissioned by George Washington, and was the first lighthouse in the US to be commissioned. In WWII artillery batteries were located at the lighthouse to protect the Harbor. Don't forget your camera. After Portland headlight we'll go to the Old Port where you can eat, and shop. Shuttle Buses will be bringing people from the Waterfront back until 3 pm. \$28.00 per person.
