### Thursday, September 4

#### TEXAS VIETNAM MEMORIAL/NATIONAL MEDAL OF HONOR MUSEUM

Begin with a visit to the Texas Vietnam Memorial located at Fair Park in Dallas. This site will include our annual memorial service. After departing the memorial, head towards the heart of the Arlington entertainment district, enjoy time on your own to grab a bite or drink at Texas Live featuring Lockhart Smokehouse and Shift4 Arena! After lunch, head to the brand-new Medal of Honor Museum. Opening in March 2025, the National Medal of Honor Museum is a museum that honors United States Armed Forces Medal of Honor recipients. Founded and funded by the National Medal of Honor Museum Foundation, this Museum will serve as the premier national institution dedicated to the stories, impact and legacy of the service members who went on to become Medal of Honor recipients.

### Friday, September 5

#### STOCKYARD DISTRICT/SHOPPING/CATTLE DRIVE

Spend the day on your own in the city once known as 'Cowtown'. Fort Worth is where the West begins, and nothing embodies Western heritage better than the Fort Worth Stockyards National Historic District. From the original brick walkways to the wooden corrals, every inch of the Stockyards tells the true history of Texas's famous livestock industry. See firsthand why Fort Worth is known as the 'Texas-most' city in all of Texas. Start your visit with the 11:30am real-life Cattle Drive, beginning at the Livestock Exchange Building. Known as "The Wall Street of the West", the Exchange Building housed the many livestock commission companies, telegraph offices, railroad offices and other support businesses. Enjoy free time to visit the Stockyards Museum, the Cowtown Coliseum (site of the first indoor rodeo), the John Wayne Museum, and the Texas Cowboy Hall of Fame. See how Taylor Sheridan's production company transformed West Exchange Avenue into the TV series 1883's "Hells Half Acre." Enjoy music and food in one of the many saloons and restaurants...such as Billy Bob's, Risky's Steakhouse, The Cowboy Channel Bar, or the White Elephant Saloon. For the shopper, there are plenty of opportunities to take home a piece of Texas while visiting shops up and down the historic town streets...The Best Hat Store, Maverick Fine Western Wear, PH Barn Door, Fincheer's White Front Western Store, The Rodeo Shop and much more.
